DESCRIPTION OF THE ACTIVITY

An educational visit to the Anatomy Museum, Kasturba Medical College for Basic Sciences,

Bejai, Mangalore was organized for the open elective students of Nutrition for Health subject

on 11th February 2023, by the department of P.G Studies in Food Science and Nutrition, Besant

Women's college.

The purpose of the visit was to give exposure to various parts of the body which play
